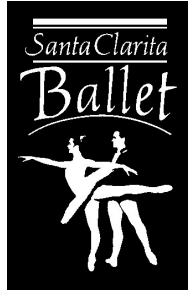

Dear Grade 3 & 4 Students and Parents:

Your summer workshop begins on **Monday, June 18th**. Please arrive at the studio by 2:45pm on the first day, and come to the main studio. We will escort you to your first class at that time.

All final payments are due on the June 18th, unless you have made payment arrangements with the front desk. All payments must be check, cash, or credit card (\$2.00 fee will apply). **Please include your \$25 family night fee with your final payment.** Daily class schedule for both Grade 3 and Grade 4 will be from 3:00pm to 7:00pm every day. Please make sure your child is dressed, groomed and ready for class when they arrive. We have too many students to provide dressing room or bathroom facilities for changing purposes. Parents, please make sure you pick up your child on time.

1. Bring a lunch and light snacks each day. **Don't forget to bring plenty of water.** Please no food that requires the use of the microwave or refrigeration, we do not have kitchen facilities for the number of students enrolled. We will order pizza on Fridays. **Please bring lunch money \$5.00 CASH for pizza. Please bring cash on Thursdays as we order the night before.**
2. **Please label all clothing, including all shoes. Everyday is an Easter egg hunt looking for lost items. Labeled items help a lot!**
3. Dance attire for girls: Ballet technique classes is as follows: **Please wear your current regulation class leotards.** You will purchase the color needed for your next grade level when you return in the fall. No skirts, watches, necklaces, bracelets, or big earrings. Small stud earrings are okay. **Your hair must be in a secure bun, all hair must be out of the face.** No T-shirts, sweatshirts or blouses over leotards. No black tights, for ballet class. Dark colors hide a clean view of muscles. Pink tights PLEASE!
4. Dance attire for boys: Black tights or leggings. White t-shirt. Black or white ballet shoes.
5. Grade 3 & 4 students will need to bring their character skirts and shoes. Dress code for Jazz classes will be a solid color leotard and jazz pants, no shorts. This keeps the bodyline visible. Please bring soft blocks and pointe shoes.
6. **Parents, prior to your student starting summer workshop, you must have completed and sign the "SCB Waiver" which was included in your workshop packet.**

The last day of workshop is Friday, July 6th. Specific times regarding parent night at West Ranch High School will be given out during workshop. The performance will be in the early evening.

I am looking forward to a very exciting workshop.
